

## Dear Community First panels

### Deadlines for funding recommendations and Community First Plan

(i) This is a reminder that the deadline for panels to submit funding recommendations for this current financial year is March 31st 2013. This is the end of Year 2 of the programme, so panels should ensure they have made recommendations up to the Year 1 and Year 2 total by then. This is equivalent to 42% of your overall allocation.

It will be possible to submit recommendations up to Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March at 6pm. Please note that this is also Easter weekend, so the last day you can contact the office in the run up to the deadline will be Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March.

It will not be possible to roll over funding into the following year, so if panels have any particular issues relating to this they should contact us at CDF as soon as possible ([communityfirst@cdf.org.uk](mailto:communityfirst@cdf.org.uk)), with the subject of the email '**funding recommendation deadline**'.

(ii) March 31<sup>st</sup> is also the deadline for the submission of Community First Plans. These will need to be submitted and signed off before panels can make funding recommendations for Year 3 onwards. ### What happens next?

After the deadline CDF will be processing all the submitted funding recommendations. We expect to receive thousands of recommendations in the coming weeks, so please note that this will extend the time it takes to process the applications, send out grant acceptance communications and process the high number of expected payments. We would suggest that you advise any projects that you recommend during this period that it will take longer to process their projects and so they should include a longer lead-in period before their activities are due to start. We expect it will take up to four weeks send out grant acceptances to all the recommendations.

CDF expects that it will take most of April to process the recommendations and Plans, so we will notify panels when recommendations can start again, which will be May at the earliest. CDF will also use this time to ensure that all panel websites are live and contain the required information. We will also be updating the guidance documents and online forms and will issue new versions of these in April prior to opening the grant recommendation system.

### Webinar support
